

Assam Cricket Association made several important announcements in its Press Meet held today after the completion of its Special General Body Meeting.

Addressing the media, Shri Romen Dutta, President, Assam Cricket Association and Shri Devajit Saikia, Secretary, Assam Cricket Association informed that it has been decided to give Majuli the status of a "Playing Member" under Assam Cricket Association, which would enable it to participate in all the tournaments organised by the latter.

It was also informed that the Constitution of the State Cricket Academy (SCA), Assam has been adopted during the Special General Body Meeting, and Shri Rajinder Singh, Former Captain of the Assam Team and a highly experienced cricketer, has been nominated as the Chairman of the SCA, which will be run by a Governing Council.

The Constitution of the "91 Yards Club", a state-of-the-art club built by Assam Cricket Association in a bid to bring back the former cricketers and officials associated with Assam Cricket Association to the thick of things, and accordingly use their experience for the progress of the game of Cricket, was also adopted, it was informed.

It was further informed that a decision has been taken to utilise the 11 acres of land recently allotted to Assam Cricket Association by the Government of Assam adjacent to the ACA Stadium, Barsapara, Guwahati for constructing additional parking facilities and commercial complex, the latter with the intention of generating revenue for Assam Cricket Association, and occupying just around 20% of the overall area.

At the same time, it was informed that the Assam Cricket Association, for the very first time, would be organising an Inter-University Tournament in the month of January 2022 in memory of Late Nilay Dutta, Former International Umpire and noted sports administrator who passed away recently
